## **NASDEA Positions Fall 2009 Jackson Hole, Wyoming**

1. NASDEA is strongly opposed to the legalization or decriminalization of marijuana.
2. NASDEA is strongly opposed to the proposition of medical marijuana, and the federal government should use the federalism statutes to enforce marijuana laws in those states that have passed state laws contrary to federal statutes.
3. NASDEA strongly supports additional funding for ONDCP for prevention/intervention programs such as Drug Courts.
4. NASDEA strongly supports a funding increase for ONDCP to create a nationwide poly drug educational awareness program.
5. NASDEA strongly supports the scheduling of pseudo-ephedrine by federal law as a schedule III controlled substance.
6. NASDEA strongly supports the clarification of federal law enforcement agencies' roles to minimize duplication of efforts, to promote deconfliction of events and targets, and to encourage the timely sharing of intelligence for the most effective and efficient use of federal resources.
